Academic Plan	Classification for academic program (major or minor)
Academic Sub-plan	Classification for Options under a degree major
Academic Group	Label for colleges under PeopleSoft structure
Academic Organization	Label for departments under PeopleSoft structure
AMP	Academic Master Plan updates are submitted annually for CSU Trustees approval; included are existing programs, proposed new programs, a schedule of academic program reviews, and resource requirements to support the plan
AS-887-934/GE	Example of a number assigned to an Academic Senate Report—it designates its source, sequence, academic year issued, and review subcommittee.
AY	The Academic Year begins with Fall, and includes Winter, Spring, and Summer quarters; curriculum changes become effective as of fall quarter.
Career	Designation for programs at the level of undergraduate (UGRAD), postbaccalaureate (PBAC), or extended education (EXED)
Class Number	Identification code for a class under PeopleSoft structure
CPEC	California Postsecondary Education Commission—It is the statewide planning and coordinating agency for post secondary education in California.
C/S-classification	A Class Size code assigned to courses depending on their mode and level of instruction; it determines the teaching units of credit that faculty earn based on the number of students supervised.
CR/NC	Credit/No Credit is a grading option for department-designated courses. For purposes of GPA calculation, “Credit” counts as a C (2.0) for undergraduate courses and as a B (3.0) for graduate courses.
ERG	Enrollment Requirement Group: Prerequisites or corequisites necessary to qualify for enrollment in a given course
Fast Track	Process of combining proposal for new master plan entry and curriculum implementation; available for existing approved option programs to be elevated to full degree programs.
FTE	Full Time Equivalent--One FTE is the equivalent of 15 units of student course credit taken by one or more students. The university’s FTE enrollment is the total course-units taken by all students divided by 15. FTE is not related to full-time student status.
FTEF	Full Time Equivalent Faculty (relates to faculty staffing)

FTES	Full Time Equivalent Students (relates to student enrollment)
GE	General Education program
GPA	Grade Point Average is the average of all grade points earned by a student in coursework taken at Cal Poly Pomona or at other institutions of higher education. It determines a student's eligibility and good standing at this university.
HEGIS	The Higher Education General Information Survey coding structure is the classification system for academic disciplines
IGE	Interdisciplinary General Education program
IGETC	The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum articulates lower division coursework among the three segments of higher education in California (CSU/UC/Community Colleges)
WTU	Weighted Teaching Units are a result of the faculty workload formula and are earned based on the number of students supervised. (WTU Calculation for 'C' Course Classifications = Units * K-Factor, WTU Calculation for 'S' Course Classifications = Enroll * K-Factor)
